WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

YOU MUST:

- ✓ Be a U.S. citizen
- ✓ Be a Joliet Township High School student in grades 9-12

- ✓ A family household income that meets guidelines established by the U.S. Department of Education
- ✓ Be a potential first generation college student (*your parents/adoptive parents or legal guardians have not received a bachelor's degree*)




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
