We have two types of scholarships for consideration this year. Students will be considered for both awards when the application is received, but may only be eligble to receive one. Here are the following scholarships and their requirements:

- 1) NAACP Joliet Branch Scholarship (Sponsored by the Silver Cross Healthy Community Commission)
 - a. The requirments for this are the following:
 - i. Must attend Joliet West or Central, Lockport East, and/or Joliet Catholic High School
 - ii. Live in the following zip codes: **60432**, **60433**, **60436**, **and 60441** (Lockport Township-Fairmont Area).
 - iii. Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater
 - iv. Submit a completed application (all documents detailed below must be received)
 - v. Submit official transcripts in a sealed envelope
 - vi. Show a financial need (combined family income)
 - vii. Submit an essay about their life ambitions
 - viii. Submit two letters of recommendation
 - ix. Submit an official acceptance letter from an accredited institution of higher education
 - x. Submit fall schedule with classes (We will collect this at a later date, before award is distributed)

2) NAACP Book Scholarship

- a. The requirments for this are the following:
 - i. Must attend Joliet West or Central, Lockport East, Plainfield /or Joliet Catholic High School
 - ii. Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater
 - iii. Submit a completed application (all documents detailed below must be received)
 - iv. Submit official transcripts in a sealed envelope
 - v. Show a financial need (combined family income)
 - vi. Submit an essay about their life ambitions
 - vii. Submit two letters of recommendation
 - viii. Submit an official acceptance letter from an accredited institution of higher education
 - ix. Submit fall schedule with classes (We will collect this at a later date, before award is distributed)

- 4. Copy of fall schedule with classes (only applicable to selected scholarship receipients)

*Only students with a cumulative 2.5 GPA and above will be considered for these scholarships. Additionally, for the Silver Cross-sponsored scholarship, you may be ineligible for this scholarship if you are awarded by another Silver Cross scholarship affiliate. Scholarship amounts and quantities are also contingent upon fiscal allocation for 2019.
