TRAINING CONTENT

Authentic learning activities will incorporate real-life experiences with English and math vocabulary, grammar, effective reading strategies, synthesis of information, expression of ideas verbally, and critical thinking and revision through the writing process. Computer training will include navigating web browsers to find targeted information, MS Office programs, email, and the creation of shared online calendars. Participants will also learn to use the Blackboard Learning Management System and gain an understanding of academic and cultural expectations.
