 Successful Completion of CPR for Healthcare Providers Certification prior to the first day of class

All students must submit a copy of both sides of their card to their counselor prior to the first day of class as

 Students must complete a JJC Dual Credit online application.
 Completion of Fingerprinting and Background Check, The fee is now included in the course fees paid for by JTHS. Students <u>must</u> have their social security number with them, and also their drivers license or State Identification card . The date that this will occur will be communicated to students at the required JJC orientation.
 Completion of Physical Exam and 2-Step Mantoux (TB Test)
 The JJC physical form must be completed. JT Sports physicals are acceptable as long as the doctor also completes the JJC form with the JT sports physical form attached.
• The JJC Instructor will provide the students with the form at the orientation and information a second time on the first day of class.
• JJC is asking the student to submit their physical and TB test by the first day of class. (Mandated to be submitted two weeks prior to the start of clinical)
• The TB test may be performed at no charge by the Will County Health Department 501 Ella Ave 815-740-4420. The hours are Monday and Fridays 8:00 a.m. – noon and 12:30 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.
 Students must purchase a stethoscope/blood pressure kit from the JJC bookstore, a watch with a second hand, and a uniform (see course policy online for description of uniform).
