The essay may not exceed three single typewritten pages. Grammatical correctness and proper use of accepted rules of composition will be considered. Points will be primarily awarded based on the overall impact of the essay on the judges. Therefore, logical and clear development, as well as persuasiveness of the essay, is important. The purpose of the essay is to provide the judges with a deeper insight into the character and beliefs of the candidate's ability to clearly communicate with the reader.
